2017 to 2020 Model year F-Series Dual/Single Alternator Conversion

Models Affected: 2017 and later F-Super Duty F-250/350/450/550 with dual alternators

Issue: Some 2017 and later F-Super Duty vehicles with dual generators may exhibit an illuminated

charging light and/or charging warning message after an upfitter has removed one of the

generators.

Solution: To correct this concern, use Integrated Diagnostic System (IDS) service tool version 104.02 or later

to configure the generator setup. These settings can be found under toolbox> module programming

>programmable parameters> powertrain.

<u>Cautionary Statement</u>: Ford Motor company does not recommend the removal of any alternator as the ability of

the charging system to maintain the proper rate of battery charge may be compromised

resulting in a no start issue

If one of the alternators must be removed the secondary alternator must be chosen.

Second alternators were added/required for certain features/options (stand alone or in combination) such as 400 watt inverter, Supplemental Heater (PTC), Snow Plow prep and

Upfitter Switches, etc.

Extreme caution must be taken when removing the secondary alternator to ensure that in some cases, battery managements systems are used to mitigate starting problems.


Changes to generator setup as well as any battery charging or starting issues resulting from the removal of the secondary alternator installed as OEM equipment in upfitter modifications
